

## AUSTRALIA

### COOPERS SPARKLING ALE

**Style:** Pale Ale  
**Country of Origin:** Australia  
**ABV:** 4.5%

The pinnacle of the brewers' craft. The ale by which all others should be measured. With its famous cloudy sediment and its distinctive balance of malt, hops and fruity characters, the old 'Red Label' is a tasty slice of Coopers history.



### VICTORIA BITTER

**Style:** Lager  
**Country of origin:** Australia  
**ABV:** 4.6%

The origins of Victoria Bitter date back to 1854. Victoria Bitter, or VB as it is affectionately called, is Australia's favourite full strength beer. VB is a full flavoured brew, less malty in character and slightly darker than traditional lagers. A gentle fruitless in aroma complements the sweet malt on the mid-palate balancing perfectly with a robust, hop bitterness.



### CROWN LAGER

**Style:** Full Strength Premium Lager  
**Country of origin:** Australia  
**ABV:** 4.8%

Crown Lager is Australia's premium lager beer. Crown Lager is brewed using only the best barley and Pride of Ringwood hops. The attention to detail in the brewing process, such as the extended lagering, helps produce the creamy fruitiness, rich malty mid-palate and crisp clean hop finish to deliver Crown Lager's distinctive, full flavoured premium lager taste.



## **PURE BLONDE**

**Style: Full Strength Lager**  
**Country of origin: Australia**  
**ABV: 4.6%**

Pure Blonde is the first beer in Australia to be marketed as low-carbohydrate. It has been specially brewed longer to produce a beer that is low in carbohydrates (70% less carbohydrates than a regular beer). Pure Blonde is a light, crisp, aromatic lager that delivers a superior taste. Pure Blonde's advance brewing techniques and pure ingredients create a satin smooth finish and is immensely refreshing served ice cold.



## **CASCADE STOUT**

**Style: Stout**  
**Country of origin: Australia**  
**ABV: 5.8%**

Brewed in Australia's oldest operating brewery, Cascade Stout is brewed using all natural ingredients, the heroes being the rich roasted barley and Cascade's unique traditional yeast strain. This stout is a favourite amongst brewers at Cascade because of its toffee and caramel notes.

The roasted barley provides deep chocolate notes which are balanced with subtle sweet toffee and nutty roasted tones. Cascade Stout has a smooth and creamy body with a slight bitter lingering finish.



## **JAMES BOAG'S PREMIUM LAGER**

**Style: Pilsner**

**Country of Origin: Australia**

**ABV: 4.6%**

James Boag's Premium is a smooth, subtle lager, a perfect balance between hop and malt.

Bright pale straw in colour with finely beaded bubbles, the lager has a fruity front palate, followed by its distinctly crisp, dry finish. This unique taste combination makes it the ideal accompaniment to seafood, a perfect match of flavour intensity.



## **HONG KONG**

### **HKBC BIG WAVE BAY**

**Style: India Pale Ale**

**Country of origin: Hong Kong**

**ABV: 7.0%**

Aggressively dryhopped, Westcoast style India Pale Ale with freshness and balance. Its robust flavors sits on a rich malt base and fragrant citrus nose.

#### **Suggested Food Pairing:**

Made for big, bold dishes with lots Szechuan peppers and the spice and heat of fiery curries, it also matches well with a sharp cheddar.



### **HKBC DRAGON'S BACK**

**Style: Pale Ale**

**Country of origin: Hong Kong**

**ABV: 5.3%**

Medium-bodied style made famous in England for its interplay between the malt character and apparent esters typical of great ales. The judicious addition of American hops during the boil and when dry hopping serves to kick the refreshment and aroma levels up a few notches.



## HKBC GAMBLER'S GOLD

**Style: Golden Ale**

**Country of origin: Hong Kong**

**ABV: 4.6%**

Lightly roasted maltiness, a prominent aromatic nose, tropical fruit accents, and a clear, golden complexion make this a refreshingly balanced, dry ale handcrafted with European malt and some of our favorite American and Australian hop varieties. Judiciously dry hopped, this is an ideal session ale for any beer lover.



## HKBC HONG KONG BEER

**Style: Lager**

**Country of origin: Hong Kong**

**ABV: 5.1%**

Copperish hue, with balanced light caramel malt profile and prominent citrus hop aroma and character, this is a beer to be enjoyed on a fine summer's day, which is practically any day in Hong Kong. Its smooth, refreshing finish will have you reaching for another one or two.



## HKBC SEVENS

**Style: Stout**

**Country of origin: Hong Kong**

**ABV: 6.0%**

Rich toasted and dark malts define this style while an addition of 5% rolled oats to the grain bill creates a silky-smooth mouth-feel and subtle layer of texture to complement the roasted malt flavors.



## IRELAND

### **MAGNERS ORIGINAL**

**Style:** Irish Apple Cider  
**Country of origin:** Ireland  
**ABV:** 4.5%

Some of the traditional methods that the clever fellow called W.M. Magners put in place 75 years ago are still used today, resulting in a balanced, well-rounded cider. 17 different varieties of apples, fresh, ripe ones that drop from the branches of their orchards, are pressed and then kept in the pitch black, without a trace of light to tamper with the taste. Only then can the juice be matured to perfection, creating their delicious cider. This is process that creates the distinctive Magners taste.



## ITALY

### **PERONI NASTRO AZZURRO**

**Style:** Pale Lager  
**Country of origin:** Italy  
**ABV:** 5.1%

This is a premium Italian beer that is brewed using nothing less than finest hops, purest Italian water, best Italian maize and malted barley and the most rigorous, quality assured brewing process. This distinctive Italian blend of ingredients helps make Peroni Nastro Azzurro una birra superiore.



## Czech Republic

### **PILSNER URQUELL**

**Style:** Pilsner  
**Country of origin:** Czech Republic  
**ABV:** 4.4%

Pilsner Urquell is the world's first pilsner, with its origins dating back to 1842. Unlike most lagers which give away most of their taste profile in the front of the mouth, Pilsner Urquell only hints its flavour. Instead, it hits you in the middle of the mouth, followed by a nice, clean finish with no aftertaste. It leaves you craving for another.





## **TRIPEL KARMELIET**

**Style: Abbey Tripel**

**Country of Origin: Belgium**

**ABV: 8.4%**

Tripel Karmeliet is a very refined and complex golden-to-bronze brew with a fantastic creamy head. These characteristics derive not only from the grains used but also from restrained hopping with Styrians and the fruity nature (banana and vanilla) of the house yeast. Aroma has hints of vanilla mixed with citrus aromas. Tripel Karmeliet has not only the lightness and freshness of wheat, but also the creaminess of oats together with a spicy lemony almost quinine dryness.



## **TIMMERMANS PECHE LAMBIC**

**Style: Fruit Beer**

**Country of Origin: Belgium**

**ABV: 4.0%**

Timmermans Pêche is made by adding 100% natural peach flavouring to lambic fermenting in oak barrels. This beer's characteristic aroma is very pleasant on the nose, and it has a velvety flavour and a creamy foam. Timmermans Pêche is a fruity drink, very easy on the palate, to be drunk with a smile on one's lips.

A powerful fruit aroma immediately followed by the flavour of the peach. A mature beer which shows clear evidence of its maceration with the fruit. A sweet and fruity flavour with just a hint of bitterness from the peach kernel and skin.



## **New Zealand**

### **MOA BLANC**

**Style: Wheat Lager**

**Country of origin: New Zealand**

**ABV: 5.0%**

Based on a German Kristallweizen style beer, but in a nod to its origins, Moa Blanc is brewed using renowned Sauvignon Blanc wine yeast. A blend of 50% wheat malt and 50% barley malt results in an elegantly smooth beer with hints of spice and uplifting esters.



## MOA BREAKFAST

**Style: Cherry Wheat Lager**  
**Country of origin: New Zealand**  
**ABV: 5.5%**

Moa Breakfast is a European style beer brewed with a blend of premium wheat malt and a variety of floral hops. A very refreshing lager with an abundance of cherry character and aromas, Moa Breakfast is more commonly enjoyed as a mid-afternoon beverage here in New Zealand. Although not always.



## MAC'S GREAT WHITE

**Style: Crafted Wheat Beer**  
**Country of origin: New Zealand**  
**ABV: 5.0%**

Great White is the Mac's version of a classic Belgian Witbier, with a smorgasbord of flavours too well-stocked to list. Like the great Belgian Witbiers, Mac's Great White is a cloudy abundance of flavour. If you fancy bubblegum, banana and Turkish delight, this is the drink for you. Fancy rhubarb and custard to follow? This is certainly the drink for you. Raspberry, aniseed, citrus and coriander on the way down? This is definitely the drink for you.



## STEINLAGER PURE

**Style: Premium Lager**  
**Country of origin: New Zealand**  
**ABV: 5.0%**

Steinlager Pure contains No Additives and No Preservatives, just water, barley, hops and yeast which are all sourced from New Zealand. Steinlager Pure uses a selection of New Zealand's finest hops, including a new variety called Pacific Jade specially commissioned by Steinlager. Pacific Jade delivers a smooth, refreshing flavour designed to appeal to a new generation of premium beer drinkers. Steinlager Pure has a smooth, easy-drinking taste that is perfectly balanced, from the light New Zealand hop nose to its crisp, clean finish.



## **SPEIGHTS GOLD MEDAL ALE**

**Style: Pale Ale**

**Country of origin: New Zealand**

**ABV: 4.0%**

This is the beer choice after a long day. Probably the least sweet of all New Zealand beers, this characteristic of Speight allows you to experience the full flavour of the malt and hops.



## **MOA SOUTHERN ALPS**

**Style: White IPA**

**Country of origin: New Zealand**

**ABV: 6.4%**

Brewed with Vienna and Pale Wheat malts, Moa Southern Alps is hopped and dry hopped with a blend of Nelson Sauvignon and Citra hops giving a strong citrus/lemon grass aroma. Add the esters from a Belgian ale yeast and coriander for spicing and you have quite some complexity in this fusion of Belgian Wit and IPA.



## **USA**

### **KONA LONGBOARD LAGER**

**Style: Lager**

**Country of origin: Hawaii, USA**

**ABV: 4.6%**

A smooth, refreshing lager fermented and aged for weeks at cold temperature to yield an exceptionally smooth flavor. A delicate, slightly spicy hop aroma complements the malty body of this beer.



## MILLER GENUINE DRAFT

**Style:** Lager

**Country of origin:** USA

**ABV:** 4.7%

Miller Genuine Draft, unlike many beers, it's never heat pasteurized. It utilizes an innovative cold filtering process that allows the fresh draft taste to be captured in every bottle.



## MAGIC HAT #9

**Style:** Pale Ale

**Country of origin:** USA

**ABV:** 5.1%

A sort of dry, crisp, refreshing, not quite pale ale, #9 is really impossible to describe because there's never been anything else quite like it.



## REDHOOK AUDIBLE ALE
